



Plas Glynllifon Limited are pleased to invite members of the public to their Public Consultation and Open Days on Sunday 24th and Monday 25th June 2018. The Open Days will be held at Plas Glynllifon, LL54 5DY.

The purpose of the event is to:

1. Obtain Public feedback and opinion on the proposal of Plas Glynllifon taking responsibility for the Country Park, currently owned and operated by Gwynedd Council.
2. Obtain Public feedback and opinion on Plas Glynllifon Limited's Enabling Development Proposals at:
 - **Plas Brereton & Plas Ty Coch**, for residential and commercial / leisure development situated on the outskirts of Caernarfon
 - **Seiont Manor Hotel**, for commercial / leisure development situated on the outskirts of Caernarfon
 - **Plas Glynllifon**, for alterations to the entrance canopy on the south wing and courtyard
 - **Fronolue House & Hotel** site, for residential and commercial / leisure development situated on the site at Dolgellau
3. To allow the Public to see the restoration works that have been carried out to Plas Glynllifon's staterooms, bedrooms and garden terrace by Plas Glynllifon Limited.

It is intended that the enabling development, if approved, will provide the capital for Plas Glynllifon Limited to forge ahead with its plans for the wider Plas Glynllifon site, as well as assist it with expanding its Leisure offering in North Wales.

Visitors are requested not to bring any bags with them if they wish to visit the interior of Plas Glynllifon and are advised that parking is limited and will be provided on a first come first served basis.

Guests will be invited to view the completed rooms and garden terrace, and will also be asked to participate in providing feedback about the Plas Glynllifon and its proposals for owning, restoring and operating the existing country park as well as their views on the enabling developments which will secure the full restoration of the Mansion and its grounds making such a sustainable business.

It is anticipated that the tour of the house, restored terrace and providing feedback will take approximately 1 hour.

Further publications will announce the opening times for the event which will be dictated by feedback and requests for attendance.

Groups and large parties can request guided tours, however, these are limited.
